## WHO

High school students and 6th-8th graders, along with their teachers and/or chaperones. Space is limited to 30.

## COST

Dig Fees: \$61 per day for 5 days

## WHAT TO BRING

Sleeping bag, tent for the dig site that can withstand up to 60 mph winds (minimum of 3 poles), clothing, backpack, water bottle, camera, sun screen, sun glasses, hat, curiosity.

5:00—Walk back to camp for dinner
