You will spend four days on the Wyoming prairie, in one of the richest dinosaur graveyards in the world, digging up real dinosaur fossils to be taken to Southwestern Adventist University for study.

## WHO

High school students and 7th-8th graders, along with their teachers and chaperones. Space is limited to 30.
