

You will spend four days on the Wyoming prairie, in one of the richest dinosaur graveyards in the world, digging up real dinosaur fossils to be taken to Southwestern Adventist University for study.

TYPICAL DAY

7:00—Wake up, breakfast, worship 8:30—Walk 1-mile to the dig site 12:00—Lunch 5:00—Walk back to camp for dinner
